Diane Lynn Saltzman and Dr. Joshua Aaron Marks were married Saturday evening by Rabbi Neil S. Cooper at the National Museum of American Jewish History in Philadelphia.

She is a daughter of Shirley Saltzman and James S. Saltzman of Newtown, Pa. The bride's father is a founder and an owner of the Horton Fund, a hedge fund in Philadelphia. Her mother retired as a social worker from the Madlyn and Leonard Abramson Center for Jewish Life in North Wales, Pa. The bride's family also owns Camp Canadensis, a summer camp in Canadensis, Pa.

Dr. Marks, 34, is an attending trauma surgeon at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital, and an assistant professor of surgery at Thomas Jefferson University in Philadelphia, from which he received a medical degree. He is also the board treasurer of the Narberth Ambulance corps in Ardmore, Pa. He graduated from Columbia.

He is a son of Susan Weinstein Marks and Louis N. Marks of Wynnewood, Pa. The groom's mother is the vice president for fund-raising at KleinLife, which operates five senior center locations in the Philadelphia area.
